Doane University Student Health Services is committed to providing the best possible health services for our students. In an effort to do just that, each new student to Doane is required to complete health related information and immunization history via Doane's student health portal, <u>doane.studenthealthportal.com</u>.

- * <u>Permission to treat forms</u>- Students who are 18 years of age or younger will need parental permission for treatment with local physicians clinics should the need for services arise. Enclosed are permission forms to be completed and signed by a parent or legal guardian.
- * <u>Physical Examination</u>- A physical by the student's physician is highly recommended for all new students and <u>is</u> <u>required</u> if the student will be participating in the intercollegiate athletic program (athletic physical form is enclosed).
- * <u>Immunizations</u>- All students enrolled at Doane University are REQUIRED to be adequately immunized. This requirement is to ensure the safety of all students from potentially dangerous communicable diseases. To complete this requirement, visit <u>doane.studenthealthportal.com</u> and "click here to register" to start your account. Use your Doane email and password to register.

Required immunizations:

-MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) 2 vaccinations are required.

-Tdap (Tetanus, Diptheria) Within the past 10 years.

-HBV (Hepatitis B Vaccine) Series of 3 shots over a 4-6 month period of time.

-Menactra (Meningococcal Vaccine) 2 doses are required if the first dose was received before age 16.

-Varicella (chicken pox vaccination) only if student has not had chicken pox 2 vaccinations are required.

The above vaccinations are **<u>REQUIRED</u>**

* Students who are under medical care or have a permanent disability requiring periodic review by a Physician are requested to provide a confidential statement from the physician to the Director of Student Health Services so that we may be able to meet the health care needs of the student.

- * <u>Dental Examination</u>- Students are urged to see their dentist prior to the start of the semester to avoid any unnecessary dental health problems during the academic year.
- * <u>Insurance</u>- Students are requested to have adequate health and accident insurance coverage as a safeguard in the event of a major illness or accident. Doane's accident insurance policy on the general student body provides SECONDARY coverage for accidents only. This will not replace your primary coverage/insurance deductible, and only comes into effect after your own insurance. Restrictions do apply.
