

For Institutional Agreement Between Doane University and Northeast Community College

Doane University (Crete, NE, with additional campus locations in Omaha, NE; Grand Island, NE, Lincoln, NE, and online), an institution of higher learning accredited by the Higher Learning Commission, and **Northeast Community College** (Norfolk, NE), hereafter referred to as **Northeast**, an institution of higher learning accredited by the Higher Learning Commission, enter into this Agreement.

The Agreement ensures an opportunity for a **Northeast** student to transfer and complete a bachelor's degree at **Doane University** effective as of the date of the agreement signing. Specifically, **Doane University** and **Northeast** agree to the following:

1. The agreement applies only to a new student to **Doane University** who has completed an associate-level degree from **Northeast** after the signing date of the agreement or within five years prior to the signing date. This agreement only applies to a student that has never taken a course from **Doane University**.
2. For a **Northeast** student who transitions to an undergraduate program taught on **Doane University's** Omaha, Lincoln, Grand Island campuses or online, **Doane University**:
 - a) will provide early advising and orientation programs exclusively for transfer students, and
 - b) will reduce tuition 15% for a **Northeast** student on a per-credit hour basis for up to two and a half years (2-1/2) for a student who remains continuously enrolled while pursuing an undergraduate degree from **Doane University**.
3. For a **Northeast** student who transitions to a bachelor's degree program on **Doane University's** Crete (residential) campus, **Doane University**:
 - a) will provide early advising and orientation programs exclusively for transfer students,
 - b) will provide an annual \$20,000 exclusive **Northeast** partnership grant (replaces any eligible **Doane** academic scholarship) to a **Northeast** student for four (4) semesters assuming consecutive and continued enrollment towards an undergraduate degree from **Doane University**. **Northeast** students may be eligible for other financial support based on FAFSA information.
 - c) invites **Northeast** student-athletes to have conversation with **Doane University** coaches in the following programs: Women's Volleyball, Women's Basketball, Men's Basketball, Women's Soccer, and Men's Soccer and Wrestling.
4. **Doane University** will accept college-level academic credits for a **Northeast** student in good academic standing for articulated programs of study, subject to:
 - a) Students will receive academic credit for transferable college-level courses without regard to instructional modality including online courses and programs, Dual Enrollment credits, and Early College High School credits. Equivalent courses need to be completed with a grade of "C-" or better.
 - b) Remedial/developmental coursework will not be included for transfer.

5. A **Northeast** student enrolling at **Doane University** under this agreement will be required to meet all program of study and academic standing requirements as specified by **Doane University**.
6. **Northeast** will help facilitate opportunities for **Doane University** personnel to participate in Northeast sponsored events (e.g., transfer fairs) and to be able to guest speak in Northeast classes by invitation of **Northeast** faculty.
7. **Doane University** will annually provide information on the academic progress of **Northeast** students enrolled as a result of this agreement.
8. The partner institutions agree to communicate program changes in a timely manner to avoid disruption to student progress toward degree completion.
9. The Agreement may be terminated by either party after 90-day notice to the other party. Termination would impact any new students who transition from **Northeast** to **Doane University**. Termination shall be without prejudice to the terms for former **Northeast** students currently registered at **Doane University** at the date of termination.

APPENDIX : Academic Programs

Students, with a completed associate’s degree, may transfer sixty (60) credit hours to Doane University. Doane requires 123 credit hours to graduate with a bachelor’s degree. All Northeast associates’ degrees can transfer into Doane’s College of Professional Studies Liberal Arts major and other majors with a few additional courses.
