Discussion:

- College Reorganization (Brayden):
 - Largely invisible to the student perspective, less change is more
 - Designed to support faculty, streamlined administrative structures
 - Have a couple of proposed examples and ideas
 - Main difference is administratively if we want "schools"
- Mariah's report:
 - Met with Becky Hunke to talk about scheduling
 - Essentially, we don't see the inside of Becky's job. They are aware of the issues.
 - They have to play a guessing game because professors turn in class schedules 6 months in advance, but we don't know how many students we will have each year until later.

- If professors are turning in their schedules 6 months in advance, why do students and advisors still not know what classes need to be taken?
 - An advisor should not be doing everything for you, they are just there to help, you need to take responsibility and be proactive.
 - The classes you need to take are listed on your plan for self service, but they are pretty broad.
 - "I need help." - President Hughes. There needs to be help.
- Students are reporting multiple problems with Enrollment Day advisors.
 - Communicate with Quint to make sure new students are meeting with advisors from their majors on Enrollment Day.
- Students really need to be proactive to figure out their schedule and find answers to their questions.
