 - President/VP Self Nominations and Treasurer/Secretary Interest due to morgan.smith7936@doane.edu by March 30, 2026
 - The President and Vice-President must be of either junior or senior standing when assuming office in the fall semester; be a full-time student as defined by the Registrar; and maintain a minimum of a two-point five (2.5) cumulative grade point average.
 - In the instance that no eligible juniors or seniors are interested in running, sophomores that currently hold a senator position shall be able to run.
 - Presidential and Vice-Presidential candidates must have served on the Congress for at least one semester.
 - The Secretary and Treasurer shall be appointed by the President, subject to majority approval by the Student Congress. If the majority approval is not met, then the senators have the right to nominate candidates. The voting procedure will continue until a majority is obtained.
 - Secretary and Treasurer do NOT have to have served Student Congress prior, according to the constitution.
